Texas, and to have the same audited and paid, and to do all acts in relation to any claim which I may have
against the State of Texas, in as perfect and full a manner as I could do if present. I do hereby ratify
and confirm all the acts of my said attorney done in accordance with the premises, and this power of at-
torney, for value received, is irrevocable.
