petitioner respectfully refers to the accompanying
exhibits, marked, B, D, E, F, in support thereof.

Your petitioner also represents, that the said
Francis J. Haskins departed this life in the month
of July A. D. 1844, and your petitioner has
been duly appointed Administrator of his
estate. - He further represents that said sum
of money or any part thereof has never been
paid, and the same is still justly due and
owing by the State of Texas.

Your petitioner therefore prays your
Honourable body to order that the said
Account be audited, allowed and paid,
and your petitioner prays for relief in
the premises; - and as in duty bound
he will ever pray &c
