That when the Western Frontier of Texas was invaded by the Mexicans, under Gen. *Vasquez*
in the *Spring* of 1842, that *Robert Johnson* went from the County of
Washington as far West as *the Rio Gaudaloupe*
and discharged and performed all the duties of a *private* Soldier—mounted, armed and
equipped as such, to assist in repelling the invaders.
