

**An Act for the relief of John M. Allen**

**Sect 1** Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Republic of Texas, in Congress Assembled, That the Secretary of the Treasury be authorized to grant to John M. Allen a Discharge for such balance as may be due the Government by reason of advances made to him by the Government while on the recruiting service

**Sect 2nd.** Be it further enacted &c. That the **(TX)** auditor of Public Accounts be, and is hereby directed to issue to John M. Allen drafts on the Treasury Department for three thousand four hundred and fourteen Dollars and seventeen cents, that amount being due said Allen for service's rendered this government
