

OATH OF IDENTITY.

R. P. Boyce of the town of Galveston
county of Galveston in the State of Texas
on this 22nd day of October One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Seventy personally appeared before me, the undersigned, a
Justice of the Peace for the county and State above mentioned,
R. P. Boyce who being duly sworn according to
law, declares that he is the identical R. P. Boyce
who was a Sergeant in Captain William Graham's
Company of the Green's Brigade Regiment of
Infantry that he enlisted on the 14th
day of April 1836 for the term of Six Months
and was discharged at Camp Johnson on the
14th day of October 1836 by reason of
Expiration of Enlistment
