STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE BY COUNTY ATTORNEY.

THE STATE OF TEXAS,

County of Travis I, J. F. Morris County Attorney of said County and State, hereby certify that, upon the hearing of the foregoing application I represented the State, and the following was the evidence:

The witnesses Thos Freeman and Wm Wilson testified as follows: (Here state in brief.) Thos Freeman made about same statement as contained in his application except that while he said he claimed Texas as his home ever since he come here in 1835 that he left Texas in 1849 and come back to Texas in 1855 and remained two or three months then returned to California and remained there until first March 1886 when he came back to Texas; A. Deffenbaugh and Wm Wilson testified that Freeman was known and recognized as a Texas veteran that he was in indigent circumstances

and the following facts were disclosed by investigating other sources of information, to-wit: (Here state in brief.)

The tax rolls do not show that Thos Freeman renders any property in Travis county and the records do not show any transfer of property by Thos Freeman for more than two years
