Hereby revoking all former Powers of Attorney executed by me upon the same subject, **Know All Men by These Presents** That I, *Thomas James* of the County of *Menard* and State of *Texas* reposing full trust and confidence in JOHN DOWELL, Attorney and Counsellor at Law of the City of Austin, County of Travis and State of Texas, have this day and do by these Presents make, constitute and appoint the said John Dowell my true and lawful agent and attorney in fact, for me and in my name, place and stead to ask, demand and receive from the Comptroller of the State of Texas any and all certificates, vouchers, warrants and money due and to become due to me for and on account of my being a *Soldier in the Revolution that separated Texas from Mexico* and to sell and dispose of the same for such prices and sums of money as my said Agent and Attorney may deem best - and to sign my name to all receipts and vouchers necessary to collect the same, and all things so done I will warrant and forever defend my said agent and attorney in the execution thereof.
