

Know all Men by these Presents:

THAT I, Cornell O'Donnell Kelley, of the City and County of San Francisco, and State of California, formerly of the State of Texas,

have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint Joseph McAllister of the County of Sonoma, and State of California, my true and lawful Attorney ————— for me —————

and in my name, place and stead, to make application to the Comptroller of the State of Texas, at Austin, for the delivery of, and to receive and receipt for, the sum of _____ Dollars in ten per cent Bonds, which will become due to me on the first day of July next from the Government of the State of Texas, by virtue of certain Acts of the Legislature thereof, one of which was passed on the thirteenth day of August, A.D. 1840, and subsequently renewed by an Act approved April 21st 1844, "Granting Pensions to the surviving veterans of the Revolution which separated Texas from Mexico," I being; by service in said war, embraced within the provisions of the Law, as heretofore proven, and set forth in the Certificate of Comptroller A. Bledsoe, dated September 17th 1842 (No. 2), which is hereunto annexed; and he, my said Attorney, is also hereby empowered to receive and receipt for in my name the silver medal contemplated by said Law as an emblem of the services rendered by the veterans of Texas.

Giving and Granting unto my said Attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said Attorney or his substitute shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof.
