The applicant said, am 69 years of age, was born in 1820, at Sandston Texas. Has never rec'd a pension, nor a Veteran Donation Land Certificate nor any property. Has sold no property in last twelve months. Has never resided in Brewster county all my life, Has not sold property to others or value of any kind for purpose of becoming a beneficiary under this act. Was in law of 1835, was at the battle of Concepcion, was at Molino Blanco, was at the Landing of Texas in 1835. Was in Capt Flores' Co. Never rec'd a pension, served from October a November until December 1835, was at Plaza in San Antonio on Dec 12th 1835. P. Flores was then applicant was a soldier in Flores' Co, same company with myself. applicant one owner
