

APPLICATION TO PROCURE A PENSION FOR VETERAN.

To the Hon. A. Masterson County Judge of said County and State :

Your applicant Samuel Morgan being first duly sworn, would respectfully state as follows, to-wit: That he here applies for a pension from the State of Texas.

I. My name is Samuel Morgan; my age is 71 years; my residence is Brazoria County, Texas.

II. I did ~~not~~ receive a pension under the acts of 1870 and 1874; I did ~~not~~ receive a pension under the act of 1876; I did ~~not~~ receive a pension under the act of 1883; I did ~~not~~ receive a veteran donation land certificate under the act of 1881. VII. ~~I was in the actual military service of Texas at the time of the siege of Bexar, in December, 1835. I was at the battle of San Jacinto, in April, 1836.~~ I was in the actual military service of Texas for as much as six weeks between the commencement of the revolution, at Gonzales, in 1835, and the first day of July, 1836. and was engaged in fighting

VIII. I rendered such service from about the 10th day of April 1835, to about the day of July 1836, and served in the command of Capt. Michael P. Seal
