who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is
the identical Thomas K. Nelson who was a Sergeant
in Captain Wm M Eastland's company of ~~the~~
W. S. Fisher's Regiment of Volunteers that he enlisted on the
11 day of October 1842 for the term of Three years and
was ~~discharged~~ Liberal at the Castle of Potosi on the
16 day of September 1845 by reason of I was not
regularly discharged an account
of the fact of capture at Vera Cruz, and
being carried prisoner to Mexico. I now reside
in the state of Mississippi
