APPLICATION FOR PENSION.

I, William R Newman applicant for a pension from the State of Texas under the act approved March 28, 1883, respectfully represent and say:

1. I was a soldier for Texas, in the revolution that separated Texas from Mexico, from about the 12th day of June 1836, to about the about 1st day of September 1836, and served in Capt. George Southard Company.

2. My name is William R Newman; my age is 72 years; my residence is Karnes county, Texas.

3. I did not receive a pension from said State under the act of 1877; I did not receive a veteran donation land certificate under the act of 1877.
