

# APPLICATION FOR PENSION.

Under an act approved March 28, 1883.

To the Honorable J. W. Pierson Judge of the County Court, in and  
for the County of Hauilton and State of Texas:

Your petitioner, Nancy Pierson respectfully represents to your  
Honor that her deceased husband John Hogue Pierson was a soldier and served  
in the war between Texas and Mexico, in the army of Texas, between the commencement of the  
revolution at Gonzales in 1835, and the first day of January, 1837. That she is a resident citizen  
of the county of Hauilton and State of Texas; aged 60 years.

(State whether or not she ever received a pension or veteran donation land certificate under any previous law.)

Received pension under present act up to 30th Sept 1883 and a here-  
before Received veteran donation land  
Certificate for 1280 acres of land under act  
of 1880 app March 15th of this year.

day of June, 1867, that she is unmarried and has so remained ever since the

county, to me known, and after being by me duly sworn, on oath say that the facts stated by the  
applicant are true and that the applicant is known and regarded in their neighborhood as the  
widow of a Texas veteran.
