Annie Liltov applicant } In County

To the Hon. Hugh A. Kern County Judge in
and for said County and State,

The petition of Annie Liltov
applicant for a pension from the State
of Texas respectfully represents
that she is a resident of said County
and State and that she is the wife
and surviving widow of Charles Liltov now
deceased and is 62 years of age and
that her husband died on the 24th day
of December 1861 and that she has
never married since the death of her
said husband Charles Liltov and
that her said husband Charles
Liltov served and was a soldier in
the Army of the Republic of Texas
in the war of the revolution which
separated Texas from Mexico be-
tween the commencement of the
revolution at Gonzales in 1835 and
the first day of January 1837, that
he was a member of and served in
Captain David C. Houston's Company
in said Army from the 16th day
of May 1836 to the 1st day of Jan-
uary 1837 that she is in indigent
circumstances now and was in
indigent circumstances at the passage
of the act or when the act took eff-
ect for the relief of Texas veterans
and has been in indigent circum-
stances from that time to the present
and that by reason of the premises
