THE PETITION of *Robert Whitlock* applicant for a Pension from the State of Texas, respectfully represents: That he is a resident of said county and State; and is *67* years of age; that he served as, and was a *Soldier* in the army of the Republic of Texas, in the war of the revolution which separated Texas from Mexico, between the commencement of the revolution at Gonzalez, in 1835, and the 1st day of January, 1837; that he was a member of and served in *Wm M. Logan's* company in the said army from *March 6<sup>th</sup> 1836 to June 6<sup>th</sup> 1836* and was *honourably discharged*.

that he is in indigent circumstances; that by reason of the premises he is entitled to an annual Pension of \$150 from the State of Texas.

WHEREFORE, he prays that notice of this application be given, that upon the hearing thereof, your Honor cause a certified copy of this application and the certificate of the Court to the truth of the same, to issue to your petitioner, to enable him to procure such Pension.
