

# APPLICATION FOR PENSION.

I, Robert Whitlock applicant for a pension from the State of Texas under the act approved March 28, 1883, respectfully represent and say:

1. I was a soldier for Texas, in the revolution that separated Texas from Mexico, from about the 7 day of September 1835, to about the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1836, and served in Capt. Bussever Company.

2. My name is Robert Whitlock; my age is 71 years; my residence is Liberty county, Texas.

3. I did not receive a pension from said State under the act of 1876; I did not receive a veteran donation land certificate under the act of 1879 & 81
