Peter Sumlinson of the town of Pleasanton
county of Atascosa in the State of Texas
on this 23rd day of June one thousand eight
hundred and Seventy four personally appeared before me,
the undersigned, ~~a Justice of the Peace for the county and~~
~~above mentioned,~~
who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is
the identical Peter Sumlinson who was a Soldier
in Captain Scurlock's Company of the
Command ~~Regiment~~ of Genl Rust that he enlisted on the
4 day of July 1834 for the term of 13/ three months and
was discharged at Remmets Point on the
14th day of October 1834 by reason of expiration of
service. Discharged by Capt Pusey 72 years
of age, and the identical man mentioned in
Certificate of J. J. Groaf Comd G. L. O. hereto attached
