20 January 1837 letter,
Sam Houston to R.R. Royall

"It is very desirable that Beeves should be forwarded from Bay Praire to the Army on La Bacca;...."

"...It is due from Bay Praire to render aid to the country for if the Army should be compelled to fall back for want of provisions it will fall back to Mercer's and leave Bay Praire exposed again to the Enemy."

"...By all means attend to this letter as the Army must be supplied! I have written to George Robinson and a Mr. Moore, and desire you all to unite with them in the important object, it may save the Army and the country."
