and upon the receipt of the same good and sufficient discharge and granting *our* said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing, whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises, as fully to all intents and purposes as *we* might or could do, if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation.

hereby ratifying all the legal acts of *our* said attorney, or his substitute, in the premises.


