, do solemnly swear that I will bear true Faith and Allegiance
to the **Republic of Texas**; and that I will serve her faithfully and honestly against all her
enemies and opposers whomsoever; and that I will observe and obey the Orders of the PRESIDENT
of the Republic of Texas, and the Orders of the Officers appointed over me, according to the Rules and
Articles of War.
