War Department, A. G. O., February 26, 1932- To the Adjutant General, State of Texas, Austin, Texas.

1. The records show that G. W. Branson, age 28 years, enlisted July 12, 1862, at Buchanan, Texas, as a private in Co. E, 30th Regiment Texas Cavalry, Confederate States Army, and deserted the service August 16, 1863.

2. Charles Shackelford, (name not borne as Charles A. Shackelford) served in the Mexican War as a private in Captain Willock's Company, later designated Captain Smith's and Captain Shepherd's Company (I) Separate Battalion, Missouri Mounted Battalion. He was enrolled and mustered into service August 3, 1846, at Ft. Leavenworth, for 12 months, and was mustered out with the company and honorably discharged, September 28, 1847, at Ft. Leavenworth.
