War Department, A.G.O., February 17, 1932. - To The Adjutant General, State of Texas, Austin, Texas.

1. The records show that Adolphus B. Mayes, private, Company D, 6th Regiment Texas Cavalry, Confederate States Army, enlisted September 10, 1861, at Dallas, age 17 years. He is shown present on the muster rolls to include the roll for September and October, 1863, but his name is not borne on the only subsequent roll on file, which covers the period of May and June, 1864, and no later record of him has been found. William H. Rhea served as Captain of the company.

2. The collection of Confederate records in this Department is incomplete, and the failure to find the complete record of a person thereon is by no means conclusive proof that such person did not serve during some period not covered by the records.
