Know all men by these presents, that in view of the present emergency and the reorganization of the Frontier Battalion, whereby it is made necessary to appoint more officers and issue commissions in accordance with such appointments, and for which positions the appropriation made by the Legislature is inadequate, Now therefore, I, the undersigned officer, for and on account of the beforementioned considerations, do hereby waive, any and every claim to the salary as fixed and apportioned by Section 20 of the Act approved April 10th, 1874, under which Act the frontier battalion is organized and continued in existence, and I hereby agree to serve the State of Texas in the capacity and with the rank prescribed by my commission for the sum of \$ 30⁰⁰ per month.
