



No record can be located in these records of Walter Scott Treadwell. We have found a "Wm." Treadwell who was a Private in Capt. Wm. Scott's Company F, Frontier Battalion from Nov. 1, 1866 to Nov. 30, 1866. Birth-place shown as Brownwood, Texas.
