He has pay due him from Aug. 21<sup>st</sup> 1870 to June 15<sup>th</sup> 1871.



I, Telesforo Montes,

do solemnly swear, or affirm that I will faithfully and impartially discharge and perform all duties

incumbent on me as a Vicutenant in  
Company of El Paso Co. In-  
fantry Men.

according to the best of my skill and ability, and that I will support the Constitution and Laws of the United States and of this State. And I do further swear, or affirm, that since the acceptance of this Constitution by the Congress of the United States, I being a citizen of this State, have not fought a duel with deadly weapons, or committed an assault upon any person with deadly weapons, or sent or accepted a challenge to fight a duel with deadly weapons, or acted as a second in fighting a duel, or knowingly aided or assisted any one thus offending, either within this State or out of it; that I am not disqualified from holding office under the Fourteenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States; (or, as the case may be, my disability to hold office under the Fourteenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States has been removed by Act of Congress;) that I am a qualified elector in this State; ~~and that I hold no other office under either the State or General Governments for which I receive pay.~~
