Final Statement of A Mouraud a Sergeant
of Capt. A H Cox Company (B) of the Frontier
Forces, born in Osasco in the State of Norway, aged
25 years, 5 feet 11 inches high, fair complexion, blue eyes, dark
hair, and by occupation a Farmer, was mustered into service by
Col J M Glenn, at Austin, on the 8th day of
September 1870, to serve for 12 months, unless sooner discharged, who is
now entitled to a discharge by reason of Special Orders No. 46, from the Governor.

The said A Mouraud has never been paid.

He has pay due him from Sept 8th 1870 to May 31st 1871.

He is indebted to the State of Texas for one Winchester carbine, and to


