

### *Warrant of Authority and Descriptive List*

Texas, approved March 29th, 1901, and Descriptive List for identification, and will be exhibited

rendered to Company Commander by bearer when discharged. This Warrant of Authority and  
Descriptive List is signed by The Adjutant General under seal of office and attested by Company  
Commander.

# ENLISTMENT, OATH OF SERVICE, AND DESCRIPTION RANGER FORCE

I, Charles C. Mossey, born in Cook County  
in the State of Texas, aged 47 years and 8 months, and by occupation a  
farmer do hereby acknowledge to have voluntarily enlisted this 4th day of  
June, 1918, as a private in the Ranger Force of this State, for the period of two years,  
unless sooner discharged by proper authority. ~~And I do also agree to accept from the State of Texas such~~  
~~county, pay, subsistence and other expenses as are or may be established by law.~~ Without Pay And I do solemnly swear  
that will faithfully and impartially discharge and perform all the duties incumbent on me as an officer of  
the Ranger Force according to the best of my skill and ability, agreeably to the Constitution and laws of the  
United States and of this State, and I do further solemnly swear that since the adoption of the Constitution  
of this State, I being a citizen of this State, have not fought a duel with deadly weapons, nor have I acted  
as second in carrying a challenge, or aided, advised or assisted any person thus offending. And I further-  
more swear that I have not, directly nor indirectly, paid, offered or promised to pay, contributed nor prom-  
ised to contribute, any money or valuable thing, or promised any public office or employment, to secure my  
appointment. So help me God.
