

1. Your letter of August 27th at hand and in reply thereto beg to advise that the records of this office disclose that a one Henry Maxwell enlisted as a private in Captain W.C. Dalrymple's Company of Texas Rangers January 14, 1860 and was honorably discharged October 13, 1860, and it is the opinion of this office that a mistake was made when his name was placed on the roll as "Henry" as you will note from the enclosed tracing of signature that his mark was made and it was signed Harvey Maxwell instead of Henry Maxwell.

2. The above mentioned roll does not disclose the personal description or age of any member thereof.


