NOTE.—One of these cards will be prepared in the case of every recruit enlisted for the line of the army. When recruits are sent from a rendezvous or station, the cards will be given to the officer assigned to the command of the detachment, or if no officer be so assigned, the cards will be sent by mail. Upon the arrival of a recruit at his destination, the post commander will furnish the company commander with a copy of the card and forward the original direct to the Adjutant General of the Army. When a recruit is assigned to a company not stationed at regimental headquarters, the regimental commander will also be furnished with a copy of the card for his information.

This card will also be used in sending recruits from stations to rendezvous.
